CAMP RULES AND POLICIES

RULES:

1. Respect all staff members, other campers and the camp equipment and property.
2. No foul language.
3. Participate and cooperate in all camp activities.
4. Encourage others in your group to try hard and compliment their good efforts.
5. Always stay with your group and your unit counselor.
6. No campers are to leave camp early without parental permission.
7. Follow safety regulations:
 - No running, shoving or pushing in the pool area
 - No fighting or aggressive behavior

Any child who does not abide by all camp rules will either have a "time-out" from a particular camp activity or have a "time-out" for the entire day. A camper may also be dismissed from camp at any time if their behavior is severe or flagrant. Future Stars retains the right to dismiss any camper in violation of camp rules or policies, without notice. NO refund will be issued for missed days, late arrival or dismissal from camp.

POLICIES:

1. Registration is on the Monday of every week. Camp begins at 9:00am with early arrival by 8:00am (7:30am for Friends Select Campers). Any camper that arrives earlier than 8:00am (or 7:30am for Friends Select Campers) will be billed \$3.00 per day.
2. Any camper that arrives after 9:00am must report to the director to sign in and will then be taken to their group.
3. Camp concludes at 3:00pm. All campers will be escorted to their cars, so parents remain in the car line.
4. E.T. campers must be signed out by the parent. E.T. is available until 6:00pm. Any camper that is picked up after 6:00pm will be billed at a \$1.00 per minute late fee. Payment must be made at the time of pick-up.
5. All campers must turn in their completed camper's information form before participating in camp activities.
6. Camper accident/illness insurance is the responsibility of the camper's parent or guardian.
7. Cancellations – Tuition credits, minus \$50.00, will be made only if the camp office is notified, in writing, two weeks prior to the start of the camp week.
8. No refunds/tuition credits will be issued for withdrawal or absence due to illness or family emergencies or vacation.
